

MGI PRIVACY POLICY

McCreadie Group, Inc. (“MGI”) is committed to respecting your privacy and recognizing your need for appropriate protection and management of information you share with us. The purpose of this Privacy Policy is to inform you what information we may collect from you, how we use such information, and the choices you have regarding our use of, and your ability to review, correct and opt out of our use of, the information. COLLECTING INFORMATION

We have several areas where you can submit information to us, and we also have features that automatically collect information from the users of our Site. COOKIES
